NOTIFICATION

WHEREAR, in exercise of the pawers conferred under section 18 of the Child and Adelescent Labour (Prohibinon and Regulation) Act, 1986 (Contra-Act 61 of 1980), the process for Amendment of the Pudus's erry Child Labour. (Archibinar and Regulation) Rules, 1995 was published as required under sub-section (1) of section 18 of the said Act of the labour Department's Notification regard vide GRI Ma No.03/ATL/Lab/G/2020. dated 30% flute. 3020 gublished in the Extraordinary Gazette No.01, Part II. dated ${\sf S}^{\sf u_0}$ July. 2020, inviting objectious and suggestions from all persons likely to be adjection. thereby, within forty-five days from the date of publication of the sold notification in the Official Gazette of Puducherty;

- 9. AND WHEREAR, the said Gasette Modification was motified for information of the contral public on 8^{th} Jttly, 2020:
- 3. AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the said notification no objections on suggestions have been received within the above said annulated time limit;
- 4. NOW, TEEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred realer soft.or. 16 of the Child and Adolescent Labour (2) of binon and Regulation Act. 1986. [Contral Act 61 of 1986] and the Ministry of Labour Notification No.3O 3081(Fig. dated November 24, 1988, the Equipment-Covernor, Puditcherry, is hereby pleased to make following rules, namely:-
- Short title extent and communication.—(1) These rules may so called. the Poducherry Child Labour (Probibliuss and Regulation) (Amendment) Rules, 2020.
 - (9) They shall extend to the whole of the Union territory of Puduckerry.
- (3) They shall come into large on and from the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

- 2. In the Puducherry Child Labour [Probabition and Regulation] Rules. 1995 [hereinalter referred to as the principal rules], upday sub-rule [1] of rule 1, for the words "Puducherry Child Labour", the words "Puducherry Child and Adolescent Labour" shell be substituted.
 - 3. In rule 2 of the principal rules,—-
- (i) for clauses (a) and (c), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:
 - "lo] "Act" means, the Child and Adolescent Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986 (51 of 1986);
 - (a) "Communities" question the Technical Advisory Communities constituted under sub-section [1] of section 5 of the Appl
 - (ii) after clause (d), the following clauses shall be inscribed, namely:
 - " '[da] "Fund" means. The Child and Adolescent Rehabilitation Fund constituted under sub-section (1) of section 14B of the Act;
 - (db) "Inspector" means, the Inspector appointed by the appropriate Government under section 17:
 - ide| "Manic pality" (means, an institution of Self-Government constituted) under Article 243Q of rice Constitution;"
 - (iii) often clause (e), the following clause analytic institution mamely:
- " '[ca] "Panchayat" means, a Panchayat constituted under Article 240 B of the Constitution;"
 - (w) after clause (h), the following clause shall be insurted, namely:
 - "(i) words and expressions used in these rules, but not colored therein and defined in the Act, shall have the accomings as assigned to them in the Act."
- 4. After ricle 2 of the principal trace, the following cules shall be inserred, namely:
- "ZA. Attacement on Prohibition of employment of their and adolescents in conveniention to Act The State Government, to ensure that the animate adolescents are not employed or permitted to work in any occupation of process to contravention to the provisions of the Act, through appropriate measures, shall

- (a) arrange on the awareness campaigns using followed traditional med a and mass media including relevision, radio, internet based application and the print media to make the general public, including the employers and the cluthen and adolescents who may be employed in congrevention to the provisions of the Act, aware about the provisions of the Act, and thereby discourage employers or other persons from engaging children and acudescents in any occupation or process in contravention of the provisions of the Act;
- (h) promote reporting of enterpreses of instances of employment of children or adolescents in controvention to the provisions of the Act, by developing and advertising easily accessible mesus of communication is sufficient specified by the State Government.
- (a) display to the possible extent the provisions of the Act, these rules and any other information relating thereto in railway exactles, at railway stations, major bus stations, to I plazes, posts and port authorities, supports and other public places including shapping content, markets, rinema balls, hotels, hospitals, Panchayal Ollices, Police Stations, Resident Welfare Association Ollices, Incustrial Arces, Schools, Educational Institutions, Court complexes, and offices of all authorities and season under the Act;
- (d) promote through appropriate method the inclusion of the provisions of the Acr in learning material and syllabus as school education; and
- provisions of the Act and the responsibilities of various stakeholders thereto, at State Laterar Service, Police, Andinial and Civil Service Academics, Teachers training and refresher courses, and Arranga sensitization programmes for other relevant stakeholders including, Panchayat Municers, Doctors and concerned officials to the Government

2B. Child to help his family without affecting education.—

- $_{\rm III}$ Subject to the provisions of section 3, a child may, without affecting his school education, in any manner, .
- (a) bein his family in his family enterprise, subject to the could from that such help,-
 - (i) shull not be an any hazardone occupation or process listed in Part A and Part B of the Schedule to the Act;

- (in sast, not include work of occupation or process at any stage of the menufacturing, production, supply or retail chain that is remunerative for the child or his family or the family enterprise.
- (iii) shall only be allowed to help to his family, or in a family enterprise, where his family is the ecoupies.
- (iv) shall not perform any tasks during school hours and herwere 7.00 pun and 8.00 sum;
- (v) shall not be sugaged in such tasks of helping which hinders or interferes with the right to education of the child; or his attendance in the served, or which may adversely affect his education including activities which are inseparably associated to complete education such as homework or any extracuminular activity assignes to hum by the School;
- (vi) shall not be engaged in any task continuously without tost which thay make him tired and shall be allowed to take rest to refresh his health and mind, and a child shall not neep for more than three hours, excluding the period of rest in a day;
- (vii) shall not include in anyway substitution of the child for an abult or adolescent white helping his family or lamily enterprise; and
- (viii) shall not to in contravention to any other law for the time heing in feare;
- (b) are present the family in such manner which is not insidental to any compation, work, profession, manufacture or business, or for any payment or benefit to the child or any other payment cache and which is not detrimental to the growth, education and everal, development of the child.

Explanation 1.- For the purposes of this rule, only-

- (a) biological brother and stater of the child;
- (b) brother or sister of the ditied through lawful adoption by repeats of the child; and
- (a) Stalogical brother and sister of parents of the child, shall be included for comprising the landly of a child.

Explanation 2. For the purposes of Explanation 1, it is hereby clorified that preliminatily, any doubt as to whether a person is biological brother or sister, any be removed by examining the pedigree of such person issued by the concerned Municipality or Panchayat, as the case may be, or any other legal document issued by concerned authority of the State Government.

- (2) Where a child receiving education in a School remains absent consecutively for therey days without intimation to the Principal or Headmaster of the School, then, the Principal or Readmaster shall report such absence to the concerned Nedal Oslicer referred to in clause (i) of sub-rule (i) of rule 170 for information 20. (Reid to work as an ordist. (1) Subject to the provisions of section 3. a shill may be allowed to work as an artist subject to the following conditions, namely:
 - (a) no child shall be aboved to work for more than five hours in a day, and for not more than three hours without rest;
- (b) any producer of any nodin visual media production or any conducted event involving the participation of a child, shall involve a child in participation only after obtaining the permission from the District Magistrate of the District where the activity is to be performed, and shall furnish to the District Magistrate before starting the activity an undertaking in Form D and the list of child participants, consent of parents or guardian, as the case may be name of the notivity and security of the production or event who shall be responsible for the safety and security of the child, and ensure that all seconding of his films and relevision programmes shall be made with a disclaimer specifying that if, any child has been engaged in the shooting, then, all the measures were taken to ensure that there has been no almost neglect or exploitation of such child during the entire process of the shooting.
- (c) the undertaking released to in clause (b) shall be valid for six months and shall clearly state the provisions for education, safety, security and reporting of child abuse in consonance with the Guidelines and Protection Policies issued by the State Government from time to time for such purpose including -
 - (i) ensuring facilities for physical and mental health of the child;
 - (ii) timely notritional dies of the child;
 - (iii) safe, clean shelter with sufficient provisions for daily necessities; and their right to objection, core and protection, and against sexual effences;
 - (iv) compliance to all laws applicable for the time being in large for the procession of children, including.
 - (d) appropriate facilities for education of the child to be arranged so as to ensure that there is no discontinuity from his lessons to School and no code, shall be allowed to work conscendively for more than twenty seven days;

- (c) one responsible person be appointed for maximum of five children for the production or event, as as to ensure the protection, care and best interest of the child;
- (i) at least twenty percent of the income cauted by the child from the production or event to be directly deposited in a fixed acquait amount in a Nationalized Bank in the name of the child which may be credited to the child on attaining majority; and
- (g) no child shall be made to participate in any audio visual and sports activity including informal entertainment activity against his will and consent.
- (2) For the purposes of clause (c) to the Explanation in sub-section 2 of section 3, the expression "such other activity" contained therein, shall make =
 - (i) only noticity where the chic bimself is participating in a aparts competition or even, or training for such aports competition or event;
 - (ii) cinema and documentary shows on television including reality shows, quiz shows, talent shows; radio and any programme in or any other modus;
 - ;e_since emarb [iii]
 - (iv) participation as anchor of a snow or evenus; and
- (v) any other arrisms performance which the State Government permits in individual cases, which shall not include street performance for monetary gain.
- 5. After mile 15 of the principal rules, the following mile shall be inscribed, namely:-
- *16A Hours of work—Subject to the provisions of section 7, no adolescent shall be required or permitted to work in an establishment in cases of such unusber of hours of work as as permussible under the law for the time being inforce regulating the hours of work of the adolescent in such establishments.
- 6. In rule 16 of the principal rules, in sub-rule (1), for the word "children", the word "sciplescents" shall be substituted.
- 7. After rule in of the principal rules, the following rule shall be inserted, namely:
- *16A. Payment of amount to shill or adolescent from and out of Child and Adolescent Labour Rehabilitation Panal.—(1) The amount credited, deposited or invested, as the ease may be, under sub-section [8] of section 14B to the Child and Adolescent Labour Reliabilitation Fund and the interest account on it, shall be paid to the child or adolescent in whose favour such amount is credited in the following coonner, namely:-

- (i) the Inspector or the Nodal Officer having jurisdiction shall, under his supervision, ensure that an account of such child or adolescent is opened in a Noticentized Bank and inform the bank in which the amount of the Fund is deposited or, as the ease may be, to the officer responsible to invest the amount of Fund under sub-section (3) of section 14B;
- (ii) the interest accrued on the proportionate amount of Found in Invoice of the child or exploseent shall be transferred every six months to the account of the child or adelescent, as the case may, by the Bank or officer responsible to invost the amount upper information to the Inspector;
- (iii) when the concerned child or adolescent completes the use of eighteen years, then, as soon as may be possible forthwith or within a period of there mainties, the total amount credited, deposited or invested is favour of the child along with interest section therein remaining in the Bank or remaining so invosced under sub-section (3) at section 148, shall be transferred to the equid Hank normal of child or adolescent, as the case may be; and
- (iv) the Inspector shall prepare a report of the amount transferred under clause (ii) and clause (iii) with particulars of the concerned child or adolescent sufficient to identify him and send a copy of the report annually to the State Covernment for information.
- (2) Any amount recovered by way of line or the composition of offences in pursuance of an order or judgment of a Count in farour of a child or adolescent for the committee of the provisions of the Act, shall also be deposited in the Pend and shall be spent in accordance with such order or judgment².
- 5. For rule 17 of the principal notes, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:
- 17. Cartificate of ago. —1) Where an inspector has an approperation that any adolescent may been comployed in any of the occupation or processes in which he is promitted to be employed under section SA of the Act, he, may require the employer of such adolescent to produce to the inspector a certificate of age from the appropriate medical anticority.
- (2) The appropriate succided authority shall, while examining an adolescent for issuing the deminate of age under sub-rule (1), take into account

(i) rite Aadhoor Card of the adolescent, and in the absence thereof; ...5/-

- (ii) the date of birth certificate from School or the matriculation or equivalent certificate from the concerned examination Board of the adolescent, if available, and in the absence thereof:
- (iii) the birth certificate of the adolescent given by a Corporation or a Musicipal Authority or a Panchayat;

and only in the absence of any of the methods specified in clauses (i) to pin, the age shall be determined by such medical authority through an assistantion test or any other latest medical age determination test.

- (3) The ossification test or any order latest medical age determination test shall be conducted on the order of the appropriate authority of the rank of Deputy Labour Commissioner, as may be specified by the State Government in this benalf, and such determination shall be completed within fifteen days from the date of such order.
- (4) The certificate of ago coloured to in sub-mile (1) shall be issued in Form B.
- (5) The charges payable in the medical authority for the issue of the certificate of age shall be some as specified by the State Government, as the case may be, for their Medical Boards.
- (6) The charges payable to the atalical authority shall be some by the amployer of the adolescent whose age is determined under this rule. **Explanation** For the purposes of this rule,
 - i) "medical nuthority" means, the Appropriate Medical Authority as defined under rule 2, sub-clause (b) of the principal miles;
 - (ii) "adolescent" attents, an adolescent as defined in clause (i) of section 2 of the Act."
- 9. Alter rule 17 of the principal rules, the following rules shart to inserted; namely:-
- 117A Persons who may file complaint.— Any person who may Eld a complaint under the Act its commission of any offence metade School Teachers and representatives from School Management Committee, Child Protection Committee, Panchayat or Municipality, who shall be sensitized to file complaint, in the event that any of students in their respective Schools is comployed in comparison to the provisions of the Act.
 - 17 B. Marrier of compositivity offences. (1) An accused person, -
 - (i) who commits an offence for the first time under sub-section (3) of section (4, 6);

- (ii) who being oran't or a guardian, commits an offence used: the said section, may like an application to the District Magistrate having jurisdiction for compounding the offence makes sub-section (1) of section 14D.
- (2) The District Magistrate shall after bearing the accused person and the inspector concerned, on an application Hed make sub-ride (1), dispose of such application, and if, the application is allowed, issue the contraction of compensating subject to-
 - (i) the payment of a sum of fifty percent of the maximum fine provided to such offence within a period to be specified in such certificate; or
 - (ii) the payment of an additional aum of twenty-five purcent of the maximum line provided for such offence together with the compounding amount specified under clause [1], if, the accused person fails to pay the compounding amount under the said clause within the specified period, and such delayed payment shall be made within a further period as may be specified by the District Magistrate, which shall not exceed the period specified in that clause.
- (8) The compounding smount shall be paid by the accused person to the State Gevernment.
- (4) If the accused person fails to pay the compounding amount under sub-rule (3), then the proceedings shall be excluded as specified under sub-section (2) of section 14D.
